



THE SECOND PLENARY SESSION

The Grand Ballroom on the 12th Floor

0800-1220, Oct. 18, 2008

The second plenary session was started at 0830 in the grand ballroom on the 12th floor with over 400 Rotarians attending. Ayo Majiyagbe led in invocation. PDG Dens Wei-Lin Shao introduced speaker of the session, RI Vice President Monty Audenart who talked on the subject of RI Strategic Plan. It was followed by the introduction of TRF Chair Jonathan Majiyagbe by TRF Trustee Sakuji Tanaka. TRF Chair Majiyagbe reported on the status of polio eradication. Past RIVP Gary Huang addressed the session on the US\$100 million challenge; he introduced the first US\$ 1 million donor in Taiwan PP Johnson Hsu of the Rotary Club of Taipei Northwest in District 3480 in Taiwan. He told Rotarians that donation was made by PP Johnson's daughter Dr. Jane Hsu as token of the piety she wants to show to her father. Gary said, she wired the donation to the Foundation on September 25, 2008. RI President D.K. Lee presented major donor crystal award to him and his spouse and then took picture with the couple together with his son PP Jason Hsu of the Rotary Club of Taipei Yenping, PRIVP Gary Huang, TRF Chair Jonathan Majiyagbe, DG Medicare Hsu, RRFCA Archi Hsu, and Convener Jackson Hsieh. Round of applause was given to congratulate PP Johnson Hsu for his major donation to the Foundation. The session recessed for 20 minutes. PDG Jason Yeung of District 3450 introduced next speaker of the session The Foundation Trustee and RI Director-elect K.R. Ravindran who spoke on the future vision of the

Foundation. It was followed by the introduction by PDG. Peter Kam-To Wan of RRIMC Alexander K.W. Mak who addressed the session on membership development. Workshops followed immediately, two in English in meeting rooms on 1st floor and the other two in Mandarin in meeting rooms on 10th floor. The workshops' topics: *A Determination of Polio Eradication; Meeting the US\$100 Million Challenge; Establishing a Vision with the Rotary Foundation's Future Plan; A Sustainable Rotary through Membership Development.*
